Misc Rules etc. (the fine print)

1. Placings 1st - 6th, awards will consist of thin ribbon streamers. Rosettes to Division Champion/Reserve with special medallions. Full results will be emailed to all. Or bring SASE to the show for results.
2. Entrants are limited due to space (I can fit in approximately 20 people). The models you bring must fit on the table you bring or are provided with. If you have a card table please bring it! You are encouraged to bring a towel, sheet, or something soft to lay your models on.
3. Entry fee: \$30/person - enter as many divisions as you want. If you volunteer to judge, deduct \$5. Check/MO should be sent and made payable to Cheryl Farrens or use PayPal, CherylFarrens@aol.com. Profits from this show go to the MGR appaloosa/poa rescue fund. Money received after 9/13/08 must include an additional \$5 late entry fee, and must be made by Money Order or by PayPal to CherylFarrens@aol.com. Proxy entries are accepted for those who cannot attend - \$2/model, max. 5 models. Or \$20 to attend with less than 10 models and lunch.

4. Tags: We will use the Region 5 Emcat system.

If you DO NOT already have an Entrant Number, email Daralyn Wallace (at RaunFalcon@aol.com) BEFORE September 1, 2008 to get one. After that date, you will need to contact the show holder, Cheryl Farrens, to get a number.

The front of the tag should have ONLY the model's entry number, breed and gender showing. ONLY this side should be where the judge can see it. The tag back MAY have the model's name and your name so you can ID them. Tags with strings can be found at most office supply stores or in the office supply sections of stores like Wal-Mart and Staples.

A LIST of all your horses must be turned in to the showholder before you leave the show or submitted by email to CherylFarrens@aol.com. This is the exhibitor's responsibility; if you fail to turn in a list, you risk losing NAMHSA qualifications and your horses' names will not appear in the results. The show manager will NOT track down those who fail to submit a list. The list MUST be in numerical order. Non-numerical lists will not be accepted.

5. OFC/Resin and CG China will be split and judged separately.

6. Performance: Classes will be split if entries warrant.

7. Lunch (chili and fruit salad) will be provided. Please bring your own beverage, and a desert to share.

8. Liability Disclaimer: Cheryl Farrens, the judges and the show committee will not be held responsible for any lost, broken or missing property or injury to any participants. Enter and bring yourself and your models at your own risk. Entry into the show means you accept this.

10. Directions: Map Quest works great! The very basics: Take I-30 east to exit 101 (Texas A&M Commerce exit). Go north (only choice). Go about 5.5 miles. On the right you'll see a sign for AAA Tree Service. Just after that is a highway sign that says Co Rd 4208. Turn right (only choice). Go 0.9 miles to 1772 (mailbox and driveway on left). There is an iron gate with "EE Ranch" over it.

11. Critter alert: For those with allergies: I have cattle, horses, a poodle, and an outdoor cat. The dog will be locked up but there are allergens everywhere LOL!
